Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Temporary Closure of: B4696 (Part), Purton and Braydon (Ref: TTRO 4948)

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire Council has made an Order to close temporarily to all traffic:

B4696 (Part), Purton and Braydon; from its junction with C67 (Braydon Crossroads) for a distance of approximately 200m in a northerly direction.

To enable: Wiltshire Council to carry out bridge replacement works.

Alternative route: via B4696 (unaffected length) – B4042 – A429 – B4040 – B4696 (unaffected length) and vice versa.

The closure and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic signs.

This Order will come into operation on 11 September 2017 and it is anticipated that the closure will be required for 16 weeks. It is anticipated that the works will take the stated duration to complete depending upon weather conditions. Pedestrian access will be maintained for residents and businesses, although delays are likely due to the nature of the works. The Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months.
