**Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

**Temporary Closure of: Ingram Street, Malmesbury (Ref: TTRO 5074)**

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire Council has made an Order to close temporarily to all traffic:

Ingram Street, Malmesbury; from its junction with B4042 High Street to its junction with Silver Street.

And to temporarily suspend the existing One-Way Order on Cross Hayes / St. Dennis Road to enable the roads to be used as an alternative route.

And to temporarily suspend the existing Prohibition of Entry Order on Cross Hayes Lane entering Silver Street to enable the roads to be used as an alternative route.

**To enable:** Wessex Water to carry out sewer repair works.

**Alternative route:** via B4042 High Street – St. Dennis Road / Cross Hayes – Silver Street and vice versa.

**The closure and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic signs.**

This Order will come into operation on 8 January 2018 and it is anticipated that the closure will be required until 12 January 2018. It is anticipated that the works will take the stated duration to complete depending upon weather conditions. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses where possible, although delays are likely due to the nature of the works. The Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months.
