86. TO CONSIDER APPLICANTS SEEKING TO BE CO-OPTED ONTO THE TOWN COUNCIL

The Council had received five expressions of interest from residents seeking to be co-opted to the Town Council to fill the one vacant seat. It was resolved that the four who had been able to attend the meeting would be interviewed in alphabetical order and if none were selected then another meeting may be held in order to interview the remaining applicant who had been unable to attend. In the event that a suitable applicant was selected and agreed to accept there would be no requirement to consider a further meeting.

The four applicants were then each invited individually to give a short presentation and were interviewed by members of the Town Council.

At the conclusion of the interview process the Town Council RESOLVED to exclude all members of the press and public from the remainder of the meeting.

A vote was taken by the councillors and it was RESOLVED that Helen Wallace be co-opted onto the Malmesbury Town Council.

87. MARKET CROSS AND PIGEON NUISANCE

The Town Clerk presented a report on the quotations received for clearing the pigeons and guano from the Market Cross and replacing the failed anti roosting wires on the Town Hall.

It was proposed by Councillor Power, seconded by Councillor Grant and RESOLVED that the locally based contractor be appointed and work be commenced as soon as possible.
