Wiltshire Council & Friends of Riverside are developing a community hub at the Riverside Centre in Malmesbury. They want to deliver an imaginative creative programme that engages with and brings the communities of the surrounding areas together. This programme will begin a longer term plan of future participatory cultural initiatives experiences.

Friends of Riverside are currently applying to Arts Council England for funding to deliver a community area wide arts project.

This project will see 5 creative objects being passed between a cluster of 4 villages for community members to make their mark during art workshops.

Using any form of creative visual expression: poetry, painting, embroidery, sketching, photography...

The project will be free to take part, and offers 5 local artists the opportunity to be mentored by professionals and then lead the art workshops in the villages.

Furthermore, once these 5 creative objects are complete they will be assembled together to form one piece which will then be toured around our community area and showcased at community events.

To strengthen our application to the Arts Council we are asking for letters of support. Just a few words from a Parish Council, or the local Village Hall who could host one of these workshops.

We have already had interest from local artists, parish councils and villages halls wanting to champion this project coming to their area.
