

## Report from Burnham House Working Group

We are pleased to announce that the plans have been submitted to Wiltshire Council for the development of Burnham House. The development will comprise of extra care apartments. There will be 49 apartments, 8 one bed apartments and 41 two bed apartments. There will be 17 apartments for sale and 32 for rent.

The management care element will be provided by Abbyfield and the developers are Leadbitter.

A working party of local people were appointed at the beginning of this project led by retired architect Mike Elam. The group have overseen the development of the plans over the last two years, and have been given plenty of opportunity to put forward their ideas and changes.

The most important change was the reduction of 52 apartments to 49 to provide improved circulation and outlook for the residents.

The changes that the group wanted were well supported by Mike Elam with plans that he drew up and presented to Abbeyfield, Leadbitter and Wiltshire Council.

A vote of thanks from Malmesbury Town Council should go to the group and particularly Mike Elam for his hours of work on this project.
