# Registration of premises and facilities as Community Assets

- 1. Purpose of report
- 1.1 To agree those premises and facilities to be forwarded to Wiltshire Council for consideration to be included in the Register of Community Assets.
- 2. Background
- 2.1 At a previous Town Council meeting councillors were invited to submit to the Town Clerk those premises and facilities which they felt should be included in the Register of Community Assets, the list to be debated by the Town Council before agreeing upon those to be forwarded to Wiltshire Council...
- 3. Proposals
- 3.1 Councillor Gundry has previously commented that asset allocation is possible when the current primary use of the building.... furthers the social well-being or social interests (cultural, recreational, or sporting interests) of the local community, and such use could continue (whether or not in the same way as before). Residential properties cannot be allocated, neither can hotels nor Church of England land. Any Wiltshire Council buildings would come under a Community Asset Transfer rather than a Right to Bid. I'm not sure if we're being asked about this but I'm guessing that a building such as the Library and the Activity Zone would be tied up with the "COMPUS" scheme.
