On the 16th of December 2014.

- Malmesbury Neighbourhood Plan has been approved at referendum and will be adopted in January along with the Wiltshire Core Strategy. Malmesbury and its neighbourhood parishes will then be covered by a County and local plan with statutory weight as part of the planning legislation.
- Dyson roundabout at the detailed design stage and had a meeting with planners and a local resident. An independent Safety Audit will be carried out and an onsite inspection arranged for the independent auditor.
- The Old Youth Centre building is to become the 8th CAMPUS. Work is now progressing under the leadership of Kim Power to assess local community needs and desires for the interior and exterior of the building.
- The car parking workshop took place. Please make sure to submit to the consultation.

- First public meeting held on the 9th of December to present the new Local Youth Support model to the public.

- Wiltshire Council Cabinet has decided on a change to garden waste collection. They will withdraw the service during December, January and February to start in 2015. More details available on the WC website

- Scrutiny Management at Wiltshire Council
 - 20MPH zoning policy scrutinised by a task group of the Environmental Select committee.

 - Scrutiny Management has developed a new draft model to scrutinise the Wiltshire Council budget and is currently working with councillors to gain their views about the new model.
 - A Scrutiny Task group has now been set up to scrutinise the needs of the 4400 Soldiers and their families who will be relocating to Wiltshire from Germany.
 - Councillors have also expressed interest in new policy development project groups.
