6c. PLANNING UPDATES

Councillor Gundry stated that the Henry George Change of Use application, which the Town Council objected to, had been granted permission by Wiltshire Council. Wiltshire Council stated that it was granted permission as it was next door to residential units, that it was on the periphery of the retail area and because the NPPF does not prevent mixed (residential/retail) areas. Councillor Gundry added that shortly such applications would need to be tested against the Neighbourhood Plan.

The Committee noted that the Priory View Roundabout application will shortly be considered by the Northern Area Planning Committee. **Councillor Gundry** to attend the Committee on behalf of the Town Council to put forward the Town Council's view.
