Issue Summary Road safety concerns Whychurch Hill

CATG Action / Recommendation

Issue The parking of cars on the side of the road on Whychurch Hill from the bottom of the hill to the small layby opposite Whychurch House. There is also no pavement in this area further up the hill. The parking of the cars require pedestrians to walk out in the busy road. The lack of pavement higher up on a blind bend is very dangerous as vehicles travelling north out of Malmesbury cut close to the wall. This is exasperated by cars that are parked on the roadside outside Whychurch House on the other side of the road. There are some dotted white lines running down from the end of the narrow pavement which require renewing and widening out in to the road.
