Report on CATG meeting – 23rd June 2015

- 1) Parking in Burnivale {CI 3453, 3455, 3457, 3505} – Issue closed however the single yellow line at the junction of Burnivale and Bristol Street has still be completed
- 2) Improved pedestrian crossing on A429 at Blick's Hill [CI 3164 & 3190] – The construction of the pedestrian 'safe place' on the west side of the A429 is underway currently. This will be followed by the upgrade of the surface of the A429 in the Blick's Hill area. Lastly two or three weeks later the coloured surface and markings will be laid down.
- 3) HGV route in Malmesbury [CI 3534] – Matter with the Town Council to determine how they wish to proceed; no further CATG action until comments from MTC received.
- 4) Improved signage to reduce HGVs in Malmesbury town centre [CI 3535] – Matter with the Town Council to determine how they wish to proceed; no further CATG action until comments from MTC received.
- 5) Road safety concerns along Bristol Street [CI 3699] – Metro count still to be completed; Martin Rose to action as a priority
- 6) Road safety issues along Whychurch Hill [CI 3800, 3963] – Town Council still waiting a response from their waiting restriction application. Martin Rose, Wiltshire Highways to set up a meeting on site with Cllr Budgen to review options – virtual and actual pavements to be considered along with concerns about lost parking spaces
- 7) Dropped kerb at the junction of Filands Road and Tetbury Hill [CI 3962] – CATG decided that Malcolm Bevan to contact Roger Witt (Senior Technical Officer WC Highways) as works presently taking place in the area and it may be that this very small item could be incorporated in the Dyson roundabout work.
