**4. MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 8<sup>th</sup> DECEMBER 2015**

**Resolved:** that the Minutes be approved and signed as a correct record.

**5. PROGRESS ON ACTIONS**

The Committee noted that Wiltshire Council have requested a plan of the works to the Bowls Club Railings before work can take place.

Councillor Budgen stated that a response had not yet been received regarding Mobile Speed Indicator Devices.

**6. PLANNING APPLICATIONS**

**100 – 13 King’s Wall**

Issues discussed included:

- That the curved wall is a nice feature;
- A similar application in 2012;
- The view of neighbours; and
- The views of the highways authority.

**Resolved:** to Object to the application. The proposed application would entail loss of visual amenity in the form of the curved wall and garden. The application is contrary to the views of the Highways Authority.

**7. RECYCLING BINS – STATION YARD**

Consideration was given litter collecting near the recycling bins at Station Yard.

Issues discussed included:

- Whether Wiltshire Council are likely to address the issue; and
- Whether the Town Council's grounds-staff can monitor the area

**Resolved:**

- 1) To contact Wiltshire Council's refuse/recycling department and ask whether cardboard recycling facilities can be provided at Station Yard.
- 2) To ask Wiltshire Council whether a waste bin can be provided here.
- 3) To ask Wiltshire Council whether the area can be addressed by street cleaners.
- 4) To enquire of the Town Clerk the staffing/cost implications of asking the Town Council's grounds-staff to tidy this area.

**8. WILTSHIRE COUNCIL BUS SERVICE CONSULTATION**

Consideration was given to the consultation launched by Wiltshire Council. The consultation is geared towards finding out the opinions of service users rather than local councils. It is reputed that consultation papers will be available on buses.

**Resolved:** to ensure that there are sufficient copies in the Tourist Information Centre

**9. GLOUCESTER ROAD 20MPH ZONE**

Consideration was given to correspondence concerning speed limits.

Issues discussed included:

- The potential cost of the proposal to Malmesbury Town Council; and
- Whether problems along Gloucester Road are speed related.
