

MALMESBURY TO COWBRIDGE PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE ROUTE

You may know that work to progress the first phase of this project, a walking route, has been in hand for some time. The Parish Council, in partnership with Sustrans, has reached the point where most of the obstacles to its introduction have been cleared away.

Thus we are pleased to inform you that the necessary construction work will commence on the route on Monday 8th February 2016, with an anticipated completion date of 11th March.

Parts of the footpath will be closed at different times during the construction phase to ensure public safety; specific dates will be posted when these are known.

It is hoped that the route will be available for use shortly after the construction phase has been completed, however the achievement of this final piece of the project plan, use of the permissive path along the railway embankment, is not within our gift and has still to be finalised but the Council is optimistic that this final permission will be forthcoming within an acceptable timescale. The Council will then notify everyone accordingly.

The Parish Council intends to organise a modest event to celebrate the completion of this long-running project; watch out for details.
