Celebrations for the Queen's 90th Birthday – Picnic in the Park

1 Background

- 1.1 2016 is the year in which the Queen celebrates her 90th birthday.
- 1.2 There are proposals for a giant street party in the Mall, London on Sunday 12 June 2016.
- 1.3 It is hoped that communities throughout the country will hold their own community events on the date to celebrate the birthday.
- 1.4 Malmesbury held it's own community street party to celebrate the Queen's diamond jubilee in 2012.

2 Proposal

- 2.1 To hold a Community Picnic In the Park in St Aldhelm's Mead (weather permitting) on the afternoon of Sunday 12 June 2016.
- 2.2 To invite all Malmesbury residents to bring their own picnic (food and equipment) to the Mead on the planned date.
- 2.3 To agree a contingency plan in the event of unsuitable weather.
- 2.4 To agree a provisional budget of £500 to support the event.
- 2.5 To establish a small working party to plan and carry out the preparations needed for the event.

3 Financial Implications

- 3.1 A provisional budget of £500 will need to be allocated from the Committee's budget.
