

Late night shopping Report

Last year during Late Night Shopping there was some concern over how much the craft market would pay for their stalls in the hub. The market stall holders (all small artisans) pay £5 for their space at the Hub market and they attend all year round.

On Late Night Shopping since we have been organizing it, we ask £25 from commercial traders and £10 for charity stalls. This is what stall holders have paid historically.

The first year that the traders in the Hub had their stall for £5 while the outdoor traders paid a different rate, there was some disappointment and frustration on the part of the other traders so last year we were concerned about the inequality.

We need to come to some conclusion as to what to do about pricing for the stalls to make it fair for everyone. We also need to understand what is within our gift to decide and what needs to be referred to Town Hall and Facilities.

We also need to decide who wants to be in the working party, and then get activities kicked off quickly.

We should also review our application form from last year to make sure it's correct to use again this year.
