Final report for the re-cycled art workshop

1. Purpose of the report

1.1 To review the success and implications of the activity we hosted, funded by the Area Board/LYN

2. Background and summary of outcomes

2.1 We were granted £260 to pay for the Wiltshire Scrap Store to facilitate 2x half-day sessions for young people in town over the summer

2.2 We used the Scrap Store for the youngsters workshop at Easter, which worked well, so we engaged them again.

2.3 The activities were added to the Heals Summer Programme and were advertised with the schools, two Wiltshire activities websites, our website, local groups (scouts, etc) and with publicity around town (library and shops).

2.4 At the first session there were 14 young people between 8 and 14 yrs, (7 boys 7 girls) and at the second session there were again 14 youngsters between the same ages, 3 boys this time.

2.5 Some of the work produced is hanging in the Hub and the rest was taken home. The pictures are on our website.

2.6 There were volunteers supporting the event on behalf on Heals (which included Cllr Grant).

2.7 There were no health and safety/sickness issues among the children.
