### TH&F/25/11 Public participation in respect of items included in this agenda

Ali and Jo stated that they had engaged with young people at the Filands Play Area about the bike jump that had been made by members of the public. It is unsafe for other users of the park and they was asked if temporary jumps could be sited at White Lion Park given the public backlash. The Committee agreed and that it would look into insurance and other implications.

It was noted that the proposed Pump Track and Skate Park work is ongoing and that the next step is to ask permission from the Council for the installation to take place. It was agreed that this would be an item on the next Town Hall and Facilities agenda.
