Thursday 26th September - SS Great Britain: from launch to re-launch. The history of SS Great Britain - Ian Caskie

Ian's enthusiasm for his subject is clearly evidenced in his illustrated talk. This tells the ship's remarkable story, from her original design through the different phases of her working life. It describes life on board and her incredible salvage and return to Bristol in 1970, her restoration, preservation, and re-launch as a multi award winning museum of international renown. Ian has delivered his talk at the National Maritime Museum and to many other groups. Ian has been a Visitor Experience volunteer and tour guide with the SS Great Britain Trust since 2007.

Thursday 24th October - Stewart Linford - The remarkable story of our National chair "The Windsor".

Stewart is a Chairmaker. He has created chairs to celebrate great British heroes. He made a limited edition Churchill Chair in beautiful Walnut wood, one of which he brought to our meeting he visited in 2023. In this talk Ian will tell us the remarkable story of this, our national chair.

Thursday 28th November - Sara Gray - The extraordinary very early history of the Theatre Royal Bristol.

Known to us now as the Bristol Old Vic of course, Sara will talk to us about its highs and lows and its heroes and villains. From a riot at the "hut on Brandon Hill", a secret door, predictions of idleness and debauchery, illegal performances, a gate crashed funeral and perceived insult to the American president, to its stars who took Bristol by storm – and an elephant. And this is just the first fifty years!!

Sara is a former primary school teacher, nearly retired drama teacher and life long theatre addict.
