Malmesbury Abbey is famous for its Romanesque architecture but it has not been known precisely when it was built because no surviving documents from the period have been found describing and dating the rebuilding. Historians have had to use the style of the building as a rough guide to the date of the building. Until now. Tony McAleavy has recently found a contemporary manuscript from the Abbey in Oxford University that allows us for the first time to understand exactly when the building work started and the precise day, month and year when the first part of the new church that we see today was ready for use by the monks. Tony will reveal his findings during his Wessex Week talk
